

BOURBONIC saved ground at the tail of the field growing detached from the main body while loping along at his own pace, tipped off the inside nearing the nine-sixteenths to the three or four path and continued three to four wide through the far turn coming under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, closed well through the final furlong issuing a challenge through the final sixteenth and was just up in the last jumps to the wire to score. DYNAMIC ONE four then three wide through the first turn, settled six than five paths off the rail down the backstretch in mid pack, went five wide through the far turn advancing steadily under coaxing from the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, dug in under a drive under late threat and was nailed in the shadow of the wire. CROWDED TRADE just off the inside through the opening bend settled near the rear of the field, tipped to the five path down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing near the three-eighths, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors. WEYBURN reluctant to load prior to the start, raced three wide through the first turn in closest aim of the leader, attended that rival to the outside five paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking three wide through the far turn, remained patiently handled steadily whittling away at the leader to take command nearing the guarter pole, got set down three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared near the eighth pole, fought on inside to the sixteenth marker, then got outfinished in the late stages. BROOKLYN STRONG broke out at the start under coaxing and was corrected, tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. PREVALENCE away well, raced just off the inside through the first turn ending up behind the cover of the leader, tracked the pace three to four wide down the backstretch just off the pace, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing just past the three-eighths, swung two to three wide into upper stretch still behind rivals, gained clearance near the eighth pole and weakened to the finish. RISK TAKING bobbled at the start, chased two to three wide in pursuit from midpack in and behind rivals, came under coaxing tipped four wide at the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch and offered no response. MARKET MAVEN hustled from the gate, established the front and went four then three wide into the first turn before establishing position in the two path, marshaled the field two to three wide down the backstretch in hand, came under coaxing at the three-eighths as the pressure intensified, yielded the front nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home and weakened. CANDY MAN ROCKET three wide through the first turn, raced six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide through the far turn and was placed to coaxing at the three-eighths, spun three wide for home and tired.
